

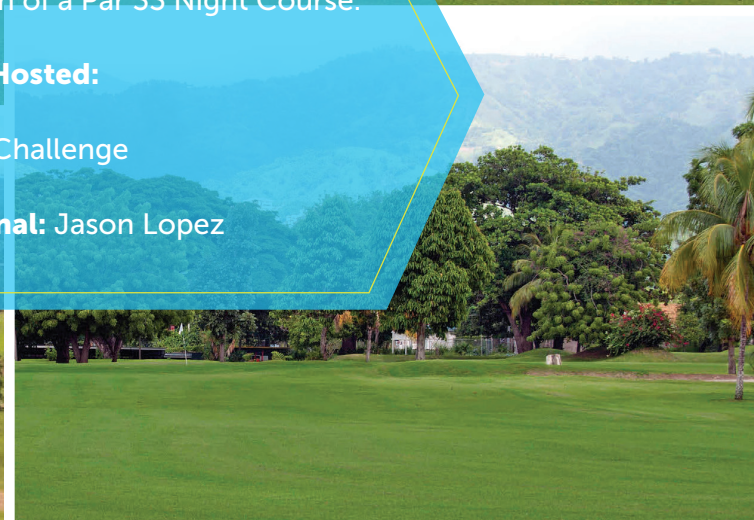
> CONSTANT SPRING GOLF CLUB

> Originally a nine-hole golf course, designed by Stanley Thompson, a renowned Scottish-Canadian Golf Course Architect, Constant Spring is known for its narrow fairways and strategically placed bunkers. Though fairly short, a combination of bunkers, gullies and ponds makes the layout challenging. Over the last three years there has been a focus on enhancing the maintenance system,

improving irrigation and clubhouse facilities and the creation of a Par 33 Night Course.

> Kingston's Home of Junior Golf

Located in one of Kingston's nicest residential areas, Constant Spring Golf Course (CSGC) is the home of junior golf in Jamaica. CSGC was built in 1920, making it one of Jamaica's oldest golf courses. It was originally a 9-hole course and was upgraded to 18 holes in the 1930s.

Jamaica's National Junior Golf Team trains at this tight, short course with breathtaking views. Constant Spring has produced many successful juniors, such as

the Munn sisters (Leiza and Jodi), Nicole Chin, Jonathan Newnham, Isabelle Marley, Justin Burrowes, Kei Harris, and Tiana Cruz.

CSGC sees an average of 60 juniors training each week, ranging in age from 6 – 17. In 2018, the inaugural JGA Inter School Golf Championship was played at CSGC.

Five secondary schools (American International School of Kingston, Champion College, Hillel Academy, Jamaica College and St. Andrew High School for Girls) participated in

the 5-day event. Champion College emerged the first winner of the tournament.

The JGA Annual Drive Chip and Putt Competition is hosted in September at the home of junior golf and approximately 35 juniors participate annually.

With the only driving range in Kingston, CSGC attracts golfers of all skill levels. The driving range is open everyday from 7:00 am – 8:00 pm.
